WORKSHEET

Think **before** watching the film!

1. The title is "*Where are my keys?*". Is it going to be serious, fun, tragic?... Can you imagine a common/everyday situation where someone says "Where are my keys?"
2. Note that this is a commercial film. What sort of product could it possibly advertise? What sort of product can you sell to someone who says "*Where are my keys?*"...

Now watch and answer these questions:

1. What is the name of the product?
2. What is the slogan of the company?
3. What is the function of the product, and how does it work?
4. What is the name of the "monster"?
5. What does he always do?
6. Can you explain the sentence: "*Send [the monster] packing!*"?
(**Dictionary:** To *PACK* is to put things (clothes, personal possessions...) in a bag or in a box or in a suitcase...)
7. Why does the clock say 7.30 and not 2.30 or 11.30? Do you think it is 7.30 AM or PM?
8. What do you think of this product?
9. Would you buy one for yourself? Or for someone in your family perhaps?
10. What do you think of the ad? Is it convincing? (**Dictionary:** To *CONVINCE* is to persuade)
